



## **Job Opportunity- High School Principal**

Fall Mountain Regional School District is searching for Principal for Fall Mountain Regional High School and Career Center. Our High School and Career Center is located in the town of Langdon, in beautiful southwestern New Hampshire. It serves students approximately 540 students from the towns of Acworth, Alstead, Charlestown, Langdon and Walpole and employs about 90 staff members.

This position is responsible for the planning, organization, administration and management of the school, including enforcing established policies and regulatory requirements, addressing issues and situations or problems that arise on campus with enrolled students, supervising staff, coordinating school activities and emergency procedures.

The successful candidate for this position will hold New Hampshire principal certification (or proof of eligibility), a master's degree with a major in educational administration or equivalent, and have excellent leadership, organizational and motivational skills and be a proven educational leader who possesses the ability to shape a school wide vision of academic success for all students by supporting a climate of learning and having a commitment to high expectations. At least 7 years in education is preferred with a minimum of three (3) years as an administrator and three (3) years as a teacher.
